

Cherri-O removes scale, rust, discolorations and stains from all toilet room fixtures, swimming pools, showers, etc.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TOILET BOWLS: If severely stained remove as much water as possible. Pour generously into bowl and on to swab. Thoroughly clean inside toilet bowl area. Concentrate under flush rim. Rinse and flush.

TOILET TANKS: Clean regularly with cleaner on swab and flush thoroughly.

FOR DAILY CLEANING of Bath Tubs, Shower Stalls, Wash Basins, Drinking Fountains, Coffee Urns, Sterilizers, Stainless Canister Tops. Dilute with 3 parts water and apply with swab. Rinse thoroughly immediately with water. Cleaner should not remain on fixtures or surface more than 2 minutes.

PORCELAIN ENAMEL: Dilute with 3 parts water. Use only if surface is not cracked or chipped. **DO NOT USE ON PORCELAIN THAT IS NOT ACID RESISTANT.** Apply with swab. Flush immediately with clean, cold water.

URINALS: Wet swab and apply cleaner liberally to inside of urinal, concentrating under flush rim. Rinse thoroughly and flush.

PRECAUTIONS

Keep only in original container. Do not breathe dust, mist, spray, vapors. Wash hands, forearms and face thoroughly after handling. **Wear eye protection, protective gloves.**



If swallowed: rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. If on skin or hair: take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. If inhaled: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a doctor or POISON CENTER. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Absorb spillage to prevent material damage. Store locked up. Store in corrosive resistant container with a resistant inner liner. Dispose of contents/container in an approved waste disposal plant.

Fire fighting instructions: Use water spray or fog for cooling exposed containers. Exercise caution when fighting any chemical fire. Prevent fire-fighting water from entering environment. Suitable extinguishing media: Foam, dry powder, Carbon dioxide, water spray, sand.

FIRST AID

Never Give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If you feel unwell, seek medical advice. (Show label where possible.)

If swallowed: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor. If on skin: Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor. If inhaled: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor. If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor.

Precautions for Safe Handling

Wash hands and other exposed areas with mild soap and water before eating, drinking or smoking and when leaving work. Provide good ventilation in process area to prevent formation of vapor. Do not breathe dust/fume/gas/vapor spray. Avoid contact during pregnancy/while nursing.
