DIRECTIONS

To remove dirt, grime, spots, and stains: Spray on soiled areas and wipe clean. For wax removal and oven cleaning: Use full strength. Let sit a few minutes then wipe away.

FOR DILUTING AND USE:

Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Wear eye protection and protective gloves.

FIRST AID

Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If you feel unwell, seek medical advice. (Show label where possible.) Inhalation: Allow victim to breath fresh air. Allow victim to or st. Skin Contact: Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by warm water rinse. Eye Contact: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get medical attention/advice. Ingestion: Rinse mouth. DO NOT induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention.

Precautions for Safe Handling

Wash hands and other exposed areas with mild soap and water before eating, drinking or smoking and when leaving work. Provide good ventilation in process area to prevent formation of vapor.
